To consider and, if thought fit, to adopt as the Club's Constitution and Bylaws the document titled "Rotary Club of Port Macquarie Constitution And Bylaws 2016" attached to this notice.

#### **Explanatory notes:**

- About every three years, Rotary International updates its Constitution and Bylaws document which it then requires Clubs to adopt. Although the Constitution document cannot be amended by individual clubs, there is scope this year for considerable amendments to the Bylaws.
- 2. At a previous assembly, the Club's Board presented to members its recommend changes to the standard Bylaws issued by RI. Amendments suggested by members have now been incorporated into the final draft attached.
- 3. The second file attached to this notice is a marked up version of the Bylaws incorporating the amendments recommended so you can see what has been changed from the original draft issued by RI. If you wish to go through this, when you open it you may have to click "edit document" under the "view" tab in Word.
- 4. For this motion to be passed, it is necessary that it be carried by at least 75% of the members attending the meeting on the night.
