Surviving in Germany During WW2



Tonight's speaker at Salties Restaurant told us some harrowing stories of what it was like as a child in Germany in the 1940s. Horst Andjelic - pictured above with Ray White (celebrating his 73rd birthday) & Lorraine Beukers & Club International Director Gai Nixon), was born in 1941. He never knew his father as he was killed fighting on the Russian front in 1942. Life was fearful & tough for a little boy & his widowed mother. Locals who did not conform to the Nazi regime disappeared. Towards the end of the war in 1944-45, two homes Horst & his mother lived in were destroyed by bombs. All the schools were bombed & so Horst did not get to go to school until he was 10. Horst's mother remarried in 1949 & the family decided to emigrate to Australia. They lived for a year in an immigration camp in Victoria & then young Horst got to attend school for the first time!


It was not easy being German in Australia in the 1950s. Horst is often asked is he German or Australian. He said he eats vegemite & always has a tear in his eye on Anzac Day. So we all shouted -Aussie, Aussie, Aussie & Horst replied - oi oi oi! Thanks Gai & the Inter team for a very entertaining night.
