
What is your favourite animal?



## Rotary Golf Day \$4000 Presentation to Marine Rescue



Tonight our club presented \$4000 from the recent Rotary Golf Day proceeds to Marine Rescue. At a special "Richard Gander Memorial" event Diane Gander (pictured above) presented the cheque to the Commander of the Local Marine Rescue Greg Davies. Also pictured is long-time golf day organiser Col Pickering & President John Sheppard. Commander George thanked Rotary & spoke about the local Marine Rescue. They have 159 volunteers & recently formed the first all-female boat crew in NSW. The Marine Rescue receives very little government support & relies on fundraising & charities such as Rotary, to raise the \$240,000 p/a they need to operate. In the past year the local Marine Rescue made 82 boat rescues with 349 people and about 20 of them were possibly saved from drowning. After 6pm each night the local Marine Rescue Radio base also cares for surrounding rescue units from South West Rocks & the Camden Haven. Special thanks to Daniel Constable & the local golf club for hosting tonight & the golf day.
