

Fred's father built a 'new house' not far away, which was quite modern! It had no running water, no electricity, no bathroom (a big round tub in the kitchen once a week dod the job!!) & an outside toilet & two bedrooms! For the first year his mother cooked over an open fire in the backyard.

Whilst in 4th Year at Coffs Harbour High School, Fred met a gorgeous champion hockey player. They both (coincidently.....o yeah Fred!!!) moved to Newcastle & joined BHP and attended the University of NSW.

June began her nursing training at the Royal Newcastle Hospital. After dating when they could, with Fred working full time & attending Uni at night & June working all hours as a nurse. They both finally graduated & were married in 1962.

Fred & June will celebrate their 58th wedding anniversary on 10th February 2020.

From these humble beginnings emerged one of our great Rotarians. Perhaps Fred's tough beginnings gave him a passion to help those less fortunate, thus he has been a great Rotarian. Thanks Fred.


