## Welcome Ian to Port Rotary

Tonight President Deb Loveday inducted Ian Davis into the R/C of Port Macquarie. Ian first joined Rotary for five years in the 1980s as a member of the Adelaide Parks R/C. He then rejoined Rotary at the R/C of Holbrook in 2016 and was President in 2019-20. Ian's wife Gail has had a lifetime connection to Rotary with her father a Rotarian for almost 30 years at the Canberra East R/C. Gail was an Exchange Student in Wurzburg Germany in 1976.

Ian was sponsored by Ted Giblin and was placed on the Community Service team in our club.

HERE IS IAN'S STORY My name is Ian Davis. I was born in the Riverland of South Australia in 1958, the third child of fruit growing parents. My grandparents on both sides were soldier settlers after the first world war and my father started his property on

land given to him by an uncle after his return from the second world war. I was educated at the Winkie Primary School and then the Glossop High School. After completing high school, I moved to Adelaide where I laboured through an economics degree at The University of Adelaide and from there, I commenced a career in public accounting. I joined one of the then "big eight" accounting firms in 1979.

I remained working in public accounting until 1995 at which time I joined a large manufacturing company as a business unit finance manager in Adelaide. In 1997, I was offered a role in Sydney so we packed up our family and moved to "the big smoke". I held a number of CFO roles from 2002 until I retired in 2014, the last being a dual listed, multinational chemical company.

I am married to Gail whom I met in 1980. We were married in 1981 and have three children, Pip, Tim and Max. Gail, like me, was a Chartered Accountant until she stopped work in 2005 after which she completed a Masters of Design, specialising in textiles.

Our daughter Pip is about to return to Australia after 6 years in London. She and her family will settle back in Perth later this month. Tim runs our cattle and sheep business from a property in Tingha, whilst Max has a smaller property outside of Armidale and works for a large rural bank.
