
Upon moving to Canberra for the past four years, he has led Canberra ROTARACT and also joined the Canberra R/C.

Our club has already worked with Past President Nsamba Henry & the local R/C in fighting against malaria and more recently providing a wheel chair for a handicapped lady living in squalor.

The program is called a Sensitisation program & hopes to raise the funds from the local R/C, Youth Ark & our club & an application to RAWCS for a grant.

President Ray is excited about this new project working alongside our continuing support for the Mothers & Babies Hospital in Nepal.
